The Community Centre offers space for meetings, events, and parties of up to 100 people. The Centre has two halls, the New Hall available throughout the year for events and the Main Hall, available throughout the summer holidays.

Within the Resource Centre, visitors can avail of black and white photocopying and access to high-speed broadband. Resource centre staff can also provide administration services - including creating posters and brochures - to community groups.

They can also assist in sourcing funding streams and applying for grants to enhance community facilities.
